Prof Ian Morgan leads the Retinal and Myopia Research Lab at the Research School of Biological Sciences, Australian National University. The Lab's current major emphasis is how retinal circuits control eye growth, and hence regulate the development of short-sightedness. In human epidemiological studies, he explores environmental (education and life-style) factors that promote short-sightedness. In parallel laboratory experimentation, he explores the optical and cellular/molecular pathways that control eye growth, in an attempt to develop preventive regimes.
